Privacy Policy

Protecting your privacy is important to Ashville Area Property Owners' Association, Inc. (AAPOA). We understand the importance our property owners place on their personal information. We want you to understand what information we collect and how we use it.

Security

AAPOA takes every precaution to protect your information. When you submit information via our website, your information is protected and not shared with any outside sources.

Information Collection and Use

AAPOA collects information in several ways in addition to the link to our property owner update form now on our website. Personal information is collected when: you provide your personal information to us direct, copies of deeds and purchase information is provided to us by title companies, realtors and financial institutions or their contractors, we review Clerk of Court and Jefferson County Property Appraiser and Tax Collector records, you contact AAPOA via e-mail through the contact form, you sign up to receive newsletters or be put on an e-mail list, etc.

The type of information collected includes: names, mailing addresses, property description, e-mail address, telephone and fax numbers and information on your preferences regarding trespass notification, how you want to receive AAPOA communication, etc.

Information collected from other areas is used for billing purposes and/or to maintain up-to-date customer records. Contact information may be used to contact you regarding your property or account. Information is stored in your record and used for membership purposes only. At times, e-mail and postal addresses are used to contact members in order to generate volunteer support for the organization or to send surveys to collect data that would benefit our community.

Sharing

AAPOA may on occasion provide names and mailing addresses of individual AAPOA members to law enforcement or emergency services when public safety/concern is prevalent. AAPOA does not release e-mail addresses, phone or fax numbers, or any financial information on such membership mailing lists to any other person or entity unless applicable law requires the release or you have signed a release for such information (i.e. financial standing request by mortgage broker, title company or other related industry). AAPOA does not release the names and addresses of community association members to other members, regardless of purpose, without a written release from each property owner. If an inquiry is made regarding ownership of a specific lot for the purpose of a sale, AAPOA will contact the property owner directly, in order for the property owner to personally provide this Interest information.
